



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Pastor's Column
– Spring 2019

Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and

peace in believing, so that you will abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. (Romans 15:13 NASB)

The Apostle Paul wrote to the church at Rome many deep things concerning the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Perhaps he sensed that he would be delayed in coming to them in person. In fact, Paul eventually arrived at Rome in chains. He spent some time there, under house arrest, and therefore was able to preach and teach in the Roman Church after all. He was beheaded by Nero in Rome.

After the glorious appearance of the risen Christ, the apostles began to travel farther and farther out from Jerusalem to meet the Gentile world – in Europe, Asia, North Africa and India. They established congregations, preaching and teaching all along the way.

The verse from the Letter to the Romans quoted above has become a favorite benediction of mine. It expresses the legacy Jesus left us, the Church, when He promised the arrival of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. Once Jesus ascended to His heavenly realm, He and the Creator God dispatched the Holy Spirit to live among Jesusfollowers. And, though we sense in our times, the chaos of a rebellious order rising up against the kingdom of Christ, we can look to the Scriptures to lay hold of joy, peace and hope by the evidence of the power of the Holy Spirit in the world.

Creation Power - The work of the Holy Spirit in creation is shown in Genesis 1:2. The Spirit of God moved over the formless world and when the Father spoke, light came into being. The power of

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God to continue the creation is expressed in Psalm 104:29-30:

You hide Your face, they are dismayed; You take away their spirit, they expire And return to their dust.

You send forth Your Spirit, they are created; And You renew the face of the ground.

When God decided to launch His plan to send the second Person of the Trinity into the world, it was the Holy Spirit who hovered over Mary of Nazareth to create in her this new life.

The angel answered and said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; and for that reason the holy Child shall be called the Son of God." (Luke 1:35)

Resurrection Power - But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you. (Romans 8:11)

It is a bit ambiguous in Scripture just who performed the ultimate miracle of raising the body of Jesus of Nazareth to New Life. Father, Son or Holy Spirit. It was the will of God the Father that He be set free from the bonds of death. Justice had been secured for all creation – the Law had been satisfied. Jesus had received majesty and power from God, so that it was His right to come out of the tomb. Scripture declares that after three days He was raised by the Spirit's energy in His cold, lifeless frame. (Holy Spirit Power, Charles

Spurgeon, Whitaker House, 1996, p 33)

Power of Witness – Jesus performed many signs of healing, control of natural phenomena and removal of evil from persons He touched. Scripture tells us He performed these miracles by the presence of the Holy Spirit. After He ascended, the disciples, including the Apostle Paul, were given this amazing gift of healing and restoration [the raising of Dorcas (Acts 9:40-41) and Eutychus (Acts 20:9-10)]. These gifts were imparted to the disciples by the Holy Spirit.

Works of Grace – The Apostle Paul wrote to the church at Corinth that the Holy Spirit has in store for all who seek Him amazing works of transformation. Imagine a household where there is strife, shouting, bitter accusation and blame. If, by the witness of caring neighbors, family or even strangers, the Gospel and the prayer of faith are introduced into that scene, the course of that family's life can be changed for good. If the adults or the children in that setting learn by grace who Jesus is, there is the potential for a complete change of world-view – from fallen Babylon to the glorious realm of New Jerusalem.

So, the kingdom of Christ on earth grows by the work of the Holy Spirit in, through and among us His obedient people.

We purchased the study called "The Action Bible Curriculum" that enables our students to use the Act Bibles they are gifted with after they leave 3rd grade. So far we have studied "God Creates the Universe" (God is Powerful and Wise), "Tempted in the Garden" (God is Redeemer), and "Brother's Blood Cry" (God is Just and Merciful). In April we will meet twice before Easter to cover "A Rainbow Promise"

(God Keeps His Promises) and

"God Calls Abraham" (God Shows Grace). The lessons consist of an introductory video showing the Action Bible in action, a lesson on the scripture of the day, and a group activity tied to the lesson. Renee Walker, who has joined in this ministry, teachers the older students, while Mariana Knifer teachers the younger kids. Snack time is always full of great conversation and getting to know each

other better and the lessons have been really interesting as we connect the Bible teaching to our everyday lives. We will not have a lesson on Sunday 4/28, but will be doing a fun activity together in its place. with a final fun activity.
